

SALE CONDITIONS

Poultry must be in good condition, free of disease and parasites, and the auctioneers reserve the right to refuse to accept any bird into the sale, which, in their opinion, does not conform to the required health or breed standard.

All chicks must be off heat.

Birds that have been brought into the UK from outside the British Isles in the previous 28 days must not be entered into the sale.

While every care will be taken of stock, no responsibility will be accepted for any loss, damage or injury however caused.

Cages will be supplied but Vendors should provide their own drinkers.

No un-catalogued entries will be accepted on the day of sale.

The market opens at 7.30 am and all entries should be penned by 9.30 am.

No overcrowding will be tolerated and birds will be removed if a vendor overstocks a pen.

Vendors and Purchasers will not be allowed to handle the birds once they are penned. Only the auctioneers or their representatives may remove birds from the pens.

Any unsold birds must be cleared from the sale site at the end of the day. No birds to be left overnight.

Hybrid birds will be sold at the end of their section. **Please ensure that you specify on the entry form if birds are Hybrid.**

The description of the birds must be true to the standards of the Poultry Club of Great Britain.

Payment to Vendors will be made by cheque one week after the date of sale.
